

# ORIGINAL

Hi friends, I made a card game for [#PrideMonth](#), it's called Makeout and it's a game where you score points by pairing up face cards to make out.

The following thread explains how to play, literally all the rules.

You need a standard 54 card deck, which includes jokers.

One person deals and you choose at random who goes first. (Unless someone is Cupid, then Cupid goes first).

Everyone gets 5 cards. You always start and end your turn with 5 cards.

Put the deck where everyone can reach it, flip the top card of the deck to create the discard pile.

Play proceeds clockwise.

On your turn, you can do 1 thing:

either draw then discard,

or score a set and draw 3.

If you draw+discard, you take the top card of the deck or discard pile, then you discard one from your hand.

Sets are always 3 cards. If you play a set, you draw 3.

There are 4 kinds of sets.

For sets, aces are number cards and jokers are face cards.

The first 2 are only number cards.

3 of matching suit or 3 of a kind.

These are each worth 1 point and they're good for getting new cards into your hand quickly.

Next is a makeout set.

A makeout set is any 2 face cards and any numbered Heart.

Makeout sets are worth 2 points each. There are a max of 7 that can be scored each game.

7 makeout sets leaves 3 extra numbered hearts: the final set.

Once per game, someone can score a set of 3 numbered hearts. That player becomes Cupid, and this set is worth 3 points.

After the last card in the deck is drawn, everyone at the table gets a chance to play a set from their hand if they have one. Then you count up everyone's score, and the highest score wins.

For tiebreakers:

Cupid, most makeout sets, most sets. If you're still tied, Cupid wins.

You can play single games or you can play to a certain score. With 3 people, first to 15 points will take at least 3 games. For one player to score 8 points in one game is a higher than average score.

And that's it, that's the whole game.

# REVISED

A card game for Pride by Adam Boyd

This game is called MAKEOUT and you score points by pairing up face cards to make out.

You need a standard 54 card deck with jokers.

Choose at random who goes first, unless someone is Cupid, then Cupid goes first.

Everyone gets 5 cards. You always start and end your turn with 5 cards.

Flip the top card of the deck to create the discard pile. Play proceeds clockwise.

On your turn, you can do 1 thing:

either draw a card then discard one,

or play a set and draw 3.

If you draw & discard, you can take the top card of the deck or discard pile.

When you play a set, you draw 3.

Sets are always 3 cards. Aces are number cards and jokers are face cards.

There are 3 kinds of sets.

ONLY NUMBER CARDS: 3 of same suit or 3 of a kind. Worth 1 point.

MAKEOUT SET: Any 2 face cards and any numbered Heart. Worth 2 points.

CUPID: 3 numbered Hearts. Worth 3 points and you become Cupid.

When the deck is empty, everyone gets a chance to play a final set from their hand.

Then each player adds their points to their total score and you start the next round.

First player to 15 points wins.
